

## **PHASE 1 OF PP**

- choose a topic and submit the topic to the MYP Coordinator by **Monday, October 12, 2009** by 12 noon
- **by Monday , October 19, 2009** supervisor will be assigned and the list of topics, students and supervisors will be posted on the MYP notice board next to the MYP Coordinator's office

## **PHASE 2 OF PP**

by Monday, November 9 , 2009

Make sure you have done the following:

- discussed your PP topic with the supervisor
- narrowed down the topic and identify a clear and achievable goal
- thought of the guiding question/ topic question you want to pursue
- described and justified a focus on at least one area of interaction ( no more than 2 aside from Approaches to learning
- made a detailed plan of HOW you want to achieve your goal, setting reasonable deadlines for yourself
- met with your supervisor every 2 weeks
- kept your PP journal notes handy at all times

## PHASE 3 OF PP

by Monday, January 25, 2010

Make sure you have done the following:

- answered your guiding /topic question
- selected and used a variety of suitable resources
- identified and used relevant information
- made a list / bibliography of sources of information
- decided how the project will be structured ( refer to the Assessment Criteria)
- incorporated and elaborated the chosen Area(s) of Interaction properly – not just mentioned them in the introduction
  
- **submitted your first draft of Personal statement to the supervisor**
- **submitted your PP journal to the supervisor**

## PHASE 4 OF PP

by Monday, February 22, 2010

Make sure you have done the following:

- answered your guiding question/topic question satisfactorily
- analyzed the information in terms of the goal and/or guiding question
- supported arguments with evidence
- identified the strengths/weaknesses of your project at different stages of development
- suggested ways the project might have been attempted differently
- assessed what you have achieved in terms of the initial goal
- assessed what you have achieved in terms of your focus on the chosen AoI
- shown awareness of new perspectives that could be investigated further
- **submitted your second draft of Personal statement to the supervisor**
- **submitted your PP journal to the supervisor**

## **PHASE 5 OF PP**

by Monday, March 22, 2010

Make sure you have done the following:

- submitted the final draft of the personal project including all the relevant information and changes regarding the PP
- submitted the PP journal to the supervisor
- submitted the plan for PP festival presentation of your PP

Here is a list of questions to help you organize the best presentation ever:

- ❖ **How will I make my presentation interesting for most of the students?**
- ❖ **What do I need for my presentation ( PC, TV, OHP, other equipment? ) When should I bring them to school? Do I need any help from other students during my presentation? If so, what are their names?**
- ❖ **How will I communicate the goal of my project?**
- ❖ **How can I present/ show the results?**
- ❖ **How can I explain what I have learned from this project?**
- ❖ **How can I explain relevant Area(s) of interaction to the audience?**
- ❖ **How can I explain to the audience everything that is important in 10 minutes only?**
- ❖ **When and how will I rehearse my presentation?**
