Croatian A: Literature Years 1 & 2

Course description 2019 - 2021

WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

Language A: literature course is offered at standard level (SL) and higher level (HL). There are 240 teaching hours for HL and 150 teaching hours for SL. At both levels, many skills are developed, especially those of critical thinking and analysis.

They will also deepen their understanding of a wide variety of concepts explored through literary and non-literary texts in order to interpret, analyse, evaluate and then communicate this understanding in clear, organized and developed products.

Students will explore four literary forms: fiction, non-fiction, poetry, drama. Also, the students will interpret and analyse variety texts from different period and culture in original language and translated texts.

The course explores elements of literature and focus on:

- The relationships between readers, writers and texts
- The range and functions of texts across geographical space and historical time
- Aspects of intertextuality

Students will focus exclusively on literary texts, adopting a variety of approaches to textual criticism and relationship between literature and the world.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

HL students must study at least 13 works of which:

- a minimum of 5 must be written originally in the language studied, by authors on the PRL
- a minimum of 4 must be works in translation by the authors on the PRL
- 4 can be chosen freely
- There must be a minimum of three works studied for each area of exploration. Work must be selected to cover four literary forms, three periods and four countries or regions in at least two continents.

SL students must study at least 9 works of which:

- a minimum of 4 must be written originally in the language studied, by authors on the PRL
- a minimum of 3 must be works in translation by the authors on the PRL
- 2 can be chosen freely
- There must be a minimum of two works studied for each area of exploration. Work must be selected to cover three literary forms, three periods and three countries or regions in at least two continents.

THE LEARNER PORTFOLIO

The learner portfolio is a central element of the language A: literature course and is mandatory for all students.

- develop and understanding or relationships between texts and variety of perspectives, cultural contexts and local and global issues, and an appreciation of how they contribute to diverse responses and open up multiple meanings
- develop and understanding of the relationships between studies in language and literature and other disciplines
- communicate and collaborate in a confident and creative way
- foster a lifelong interest in and enjoyment of language and literature
