CAS Project Proposal

Title of project: OneTreePlanted

Focus and details about the project

The general idea about the project came to my mind while I was reading a plan and program sheet about an Erasmus environment sustainability project Upcycle it. The aim of the project was to spread awareness about recycling and environmental projects all over Europe. One of such projects mentioned was the reforestation project of the organization OneTreePlanted. It is a nonprofit environmental tree planting charity that plants trees in countries around the world. Their goal is to reestablish woodland, improve water and soil quality and create a habitat for wildlife in historically forested areas, consequently lowering the carbon dioxide concentration in the atmosphere.

This CAS project would involve creating small posters containing information about the charity and its goals as well as what they have accomplished so far. In addition to this, underneath each poster I would position a trash can in which people can throw plastic water bottles. These trash cans would be put in the school for two months (starting in March and ending in May) so that enough bottles are collected. At the end of each week, I would collect the bottles and take them to a store such as Konzum which gives its customers 7 cents for each plastic bottle they bring in for recycling. After two months all the money earned from the bottles would be gathered and donated to the charity so that more trees can be planted around Europe (one tree is worth 2 euros). Consequently, these bottles would be considered a donation to the charity from everyone who recycles the bottles in the designated trash cans, therefore involving the entire school community to a good, globally significant cause.

Both the cans and the poster materials would be purchased and provided by the members of the project.

1. Knowledgeable

The project will involve exploring ideas and concepts related to recycling and the importance of reforestation on a global scale. It will serve as a good way of gaining new, in-depth knowledge about the topics. Such topics are the importance of recycling as well as the importance of being environmentally aware. Knowledge of such topics will help us create better and more educational

posters regarding the topic. These posters will not only promote the project itself but also spread awareness about the importance of reforestation.

2. Reflective

After the project is finished, a reflection about the impact and the implications of the importance of such an initiative will be thoroughly discussed in my CAS journal. This reflection will include all the details regarding the planning and the execution of the actual project. In addition to this it will discuss all the CAS stages and learning outcomes achieved throughout the project. This will help us better reflect on all the challenges we faced and overcame during different stages of the CAS project. This will help us know better for our second CAS project this year.

3. Caring

The project involves personal commitment to the service and the act of making a positive difference to the environment on a global scale.

CAS Learning outcomes involved

1. <u>Identify own strengths and develop areas for growth</u>

Throughout the CAS experience I would learn more about environment sustainability projects OneTreePlanted and other nonprofitable organisations are involved with.
